What is trypraying?

The logo.

The trypraying logo is a simple and attractive invitation for people to consider doing life with God. When it is put into the public space with advertising and banners on churches the invitation goes to the whole community.

The booklet.

This seven day prayer guide helps a person begin a relationship with God. It explains the good news about Jesus and invites a person to trust him. At the same time it enables a person to pray about something important to them with ideas and information.

The project.

For a church: everyone uses the booklet themselves one week and the following week everyone is encouraged to give it to a friend, neighbour or colleague - Use it and lose it! Simple.

For a city: churches unite to do this together.

Why.

It invites people to experience the kindness of God. People are afraid and living without hope. Past certainties have been swept away and people are asking questions and seeking answers. Trypraying is a resource that enables people to share their faith, churches to do mission and groups of churches to work together.
